MARTINA PREVEJŠEK graduated in singing at Music Conservatory Ljubljana, Slovenia. She also studied biology at the Biotechnical Faculty in Ljubljana, and Vocal Performance and Vocal Pedagogy at the Academy of Music in Ljubljana, where she graduated in 2003. In 2013, she completed a scientific Master's studies in Management at the Faculty of Management in Koper, Slovenia. In 2018 she finished the Pro Vox Specialization Course Sciences of Voice, Speech, and Singing at the University of Coimbra, Portugal. In 2021 she was certified as Vocal Health First Aider from Vocal Health Education London, UK. In 2022 she was certified for Somatic Voicework[™] the LoVetri Method, level I, II, and III. From Total Vocal Freedom she was certified for using Alexander technique principles in voice teaching, levels I, and II.

Currently, she is finishing her certification as a Pranayama breathing techniques teacher and Life Awareness instructor.

She works as a teacher of singing and chamber music at the Music school Sevnica. Her students successfully participate in regional, national, and international singing competitions. From 2008 to 2012 she was the president of the Association of Slovenian Singing Teachers., she has organized singing masterclasses with Prof. Marvin Keenze - USA, dr. Scott McCoy - USA, and Prof. Norma Enns – Germany, prof. Dunja Vejzović – Croatia in Ljubljana and with Dr. Katharina Rössner (AUT) in Sevnica. She has organized several voice congresses Slovenian singing days, and singing concerts for the winners of TEMSIG – a Slovenian national music competition. In cooperation with EVTA – the European voice teachers association she was

included in the international project Leonardo da Vinci Lifelong learning program, in which she organized the 4th European Voice pedagogy week in Ljubljana on using digital technology in teaching singing. In 2018, Lambert Academic Publisher published her book Cooperation Between a Music School and the Environment.

She is a founder (2021) and director of the Mind Body Voice Education Institute MBVEI, whose mission is through lectures, workshops, and online courses to teach school teachers and educators about vocal health and effective voice use in teaching. She cooperates with the National Institute for Education as a lecturer for the study groups for music teachers and educators.

Several times she actively participated in the International Artistic and Scientific Symposium on Choral Art, Singing and Voice - ARS CHORALIS (Croatia), in EVTA&DSPP International Symposium on Vocal Pedagogy, Singing, Voice - Jewels of European Vocal Pedagogy (Slovenia), and International Conferences on the Promotion of Teachers' Health in Education (Slovenia). She attended intensive education courses in The Science of the singing voice in Sweden conducted by Dr. Johan Sundberg, Dr. Filipa Lã, and Dr. Brian Gill (2023), courses in Building Voice of Vienna Boys Choir with Monika Hosp in Austria (2018), Voice Teaching in Pre-puberty, Puberty and after Puberty with Monika Hosp in Austria (2018), Teaching singing to children and young adults with dr. Jenevora Williams (2023) and many more.

With the group KUD Slovenija, she has performed Slovenian folk and popular music in Slovenija, Austria, Italy, and Croatia, she has also performed as a classical singer-soloist with different orchestras. She was the vice president of the expert council for Culture. She is a wife, a mother of two teenagers, a singer-songwriter, lover of yoga, meditation, walks in nature, and fresh air.
